On Saturday, January 21, Right to Life of Central California brought two buses of supporters to the 2023 **Walk for Life West Coast** in San Francisco. This annual event, which drew an estimated 30,000 participants, was a powerful witness to the sanctity of life in the heart of pro-choice California.

The event began with a rally in front of City Hall in San Francisco in the large, open field of the Civic Center. The speakers included Frank Pavone, Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone, Rev. Clenard Childress, Jr., and others. Many speakers highlighted their personal histories with abortion, including the families who stepped forward to tell their stories of regret, hope, and healing through the Silent No More campaign.

The pro-choice counter-protesters were quite loud, with several using megaphones to try (unsuccessfully) to drown out the joyful music, songs, and prayers of the assembled marchers. The marchers seemed to be a younger, more diverse, and far less angry crowd than the counter-protesters. The officers from the San Francisco Police Department did an excellent job of maintaining order, keeping counter-protesters safely cordoned off from the main route of the March.

After the rally was concluded, the assembled marchers proceeded down Mission St. to the Embarcadero, where the event concluded. It was so wonderful to see so many pro-life friends from throughout California and throughout the country. We are looking forward to our next bus trip, to the **California March for Life** at the Capitol building in Sacramento on Monday, March 6! 

RIGHT TO LIFE LEGISLATION

Remember These 2023 California Bills

The California Legislature is now in session, with new bills being introduced through February. The Legislature has been guided in its abortion bills by the California Future of Abortion Council, a consortium of organizations that have recommended and drafted aggressive abortion legislation. *13 abortion bills were enacted just last year, and more are on the way.*

HR 6 & SR 9:

These are resolutions within the California State Assembly and State Senate urging the US Congress to adopt legislation codifying a right to abortion and contraception. Joe Biden and Democrat leadership in Congress has pledged to attempt to “codify” the provisions of Roe v. Wade, and enforce nationwide legal abortion, overriding new post-Dobbs state laws limiting legal abortion.

SB 36:

This law prohibits California courts from cooperating with other states’ criminal justice proceedings regarding abortion. Since the Dobbs decision, a number of states have outlawed abortion, with criminal penalties against doctors who perform them. By this law, California courts cannot participate in the arrest or detention of fugitives fleeing to California for their crimes.

(Federal) Protecting Life on College Campus Act

Rep. Chip Roy (R, TX) and Sen. Steve Daines (R, MT) have introduced this legislation as a nationwide bill to cut federal funding to any college or university that provides the abortion pill on campus. This is particularly relevant to California, where the 2019 law SB 24 now mandates that the abortion pill be provided at all UC and CSU campus health centers. While the Democrat-controlled Senate is unlikely to pass this legislation and President Biden would likely veto it, it is important for highlighting the extreme actions of far too many colleges and universities to provide students with the means to kill their babies.


More abortion bills are likely to be introduced in the weeks ahead. We are particularly on the lookout for legislation explicitly allowing doctors to perform post-viability abortions without any indication of a risk to maternal health. WHAT CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED IN A WEEKEND RETREAT FOR HEALING POST ABORTION TRAUMA?

The **Rachel's Vineyard** weekend retreat ministry offers an intensive process for healing the pain of abortion. Traditionally, post abortion healing treatment models were designed as a one-on-one healing journey with a priest, minister, professional counselor, or a para-professional. The length of time would vary upon individual need. The **Rachel's Vineyard Retreat Ministry** was developed in the mid 1990s and has proven to be an effective and powerful treatment modality ever since. It is extremely valuable as it provides an uninterrupted weekend experience in order to accomplish this very intensive grief work. It easily fits into the schedule of people with busy lives and therefore does not require a time commitment spanning many months. *It also provides the advantage of having*

a weekend away from the normal distractions and interruptions of work, family life, and relationships. It enables the participants to enter into the grief process in a private and confidential setting in a very direct and focused way.

Emotional and spiritual support, counseling, and encouragement are available day and night throughout the entire weekend. The format provides a specific process which includes the necessary steps for post abortion healing. It provides the advantage of the presence of a healing team with training and experience in the many foundational wounded areas of the post abortive person's life. The group dynamics can be very cathartic in helping the participants surface and release deep and powerful feelings of sadness, depression, grief, guilt,

shame, and anger. The scripture readings, prayer, meditations, and rituals reveal God's love, mercy, compassion, and forgiveness and invite repentance and reconciliation. The weekend incorporates sound psychological principles combined with the magnanimous healing power of God's grace. **It offers in 30 hours what would ordinarily take 8 months of weekly appointments.**
