- What options do women have other than abortion?
- What about pregnancies where the mother's life is threatened?
- How many abortions happen in America?
- How is an unborn child valuable when it is so small/underdeveloped?
- How is an unborn child valuable when it is so dependent?
- What should our attitude be to women who have had abortions?
- Do women who have abortions suffer from mental health disorders because of it?
- What about pregnancies where the mother's life is in danger?
- Roe v. Wade – What did it do and what happens now that it's overturned?
- When does a baby become a "person"?
- Why should the government tell women what to do with their pregnancies? Should the government be allowed to ban abortion?
- Why can't women exercise control over their own bodies? (Hint: is it *just* their own body?)
- How developed is a baby during an abortion? Is it a "clump of cells?"
- Are abortions ever medically necessary?
